**Traditional**

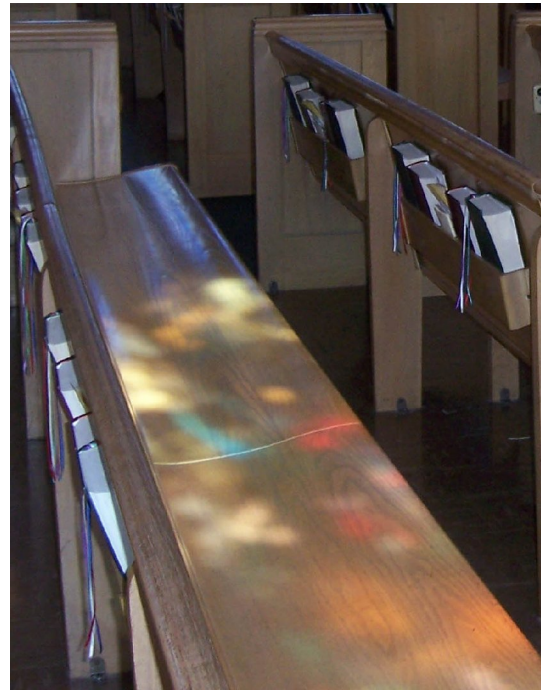
**SUNDAY 10:15 AM**
